tirol kliniken trusts in the solutions of Meona GmbH, a company of the Mesalvo Group, and orders the new HIS System

By 2024, the existing hospital information system (HIS) of tirol kliniken GmbH will be replaced by the Meona software. Central elements are the introduction of the Meona chart and the Meona Medication Management System (AMTS) to replace the existing paper documentation.

The Meona HIS will be accessible to all hospitals of the tirol kliniken GmbH to ensure the continuous documentation for patients and seamless flow of information between the hospitals. For this purpose, all medical, therapeutic and nursing workflows will be digitally supported. "We are pleased to have found a strategic cooperation partner for our new HIS software in Meona" says Johannes Ebner, MSc., project manager for the tender of the tirol kliniken.

With around 9,200 employees, 2,450 beds, 115,000 hospital admissions and 1.1 million ambulatory treatments per year, the tirol kliniken is the largest and most diverse health care provider in western Austria. As a holding company, the tirol kliniken GmbH operates the following three provincial hospitals: A.ö. Landeskrankenhaus (university hospital) Innsbruck, A.ö. Landeskrankenhaus Hall i.T. and A.ö. Landeskrankenhaus Hochzirl - Natters (with two locations) as well as the Landes-Pflegeklinik Tirol and the Ausbildungszentrum West für Gesundheitsberufe (AZW). In order to guarantee a high quality of services in their hospitals, the tirol kliniken not only focuses on highly qualified and committed employees, but also on the introduction of a new hospital information system (HIS) with a focus on charts and medication management. The HIS software already in use (the product Millennium by the company Cerner) is to be replaced by the Meona application by the end of 2024.

Meona is one of the few hospital information systems to be fully certified as a medical device. Since 2021, Meona has been part of a group of companies, the Mesalvo Group, together with E.care BVBA from Belgium and i-SOLUTIONS Health GmbH from Germany.

Whether for doctors, therapists or nurses - in the future Meona will support all workflows in the tirol kliniken and will promote cooperation and digital communication between the hospitals. Continuity of care is the main focus of the implementation of the HIS.

The Meona HIS offers a significant reduction in workload not only for medical, nursing or therapeutic clinic employees, but also for the administration. As a clinical decision support system (CDSS), Meona offers multiple options for documenting and mapping corresponding workflows. Furthermore, e.g. mobile application facilitate the focus on essential patient information.
